Subject: REACH Declaration of Conformity

Under the REACH Regulation, ALMECO S.p.A. defines itself as a manufacturer of "ITEMS or ARTICLES" and, therefore, does not require registration, pre-registration, or authorization for the products it supplies.

With regard to the requirements of **Article 33** of REACH, ALMECO S.p.A. declares that none of the products it supplies contain substances included in the "**Candidate List of SVHC (Substances of Very High Concern)**" in Concentration equal to or greater than 0.1%.

Furthermore, with regard to the requirements of **Article 67** of REACH (*A substance on its own, in a preparation or in an article, listed in Annex XVII, subject to restrictions on use shall not be placed on the European market or used unless it complies with the conditions of that restriction*), ALMECO S.p.A. declares that none of the substances subject to restrictions on use are present in the products it supplies.

European market, was revised by a provision published in the European Official Journal on **June 3, 2025**. The revision introduced restrictions for two substances classified under the CLP Regulation as "toxic to reproduction" and "acute toxicity":

- *N,N-dimethylacetamide (DMAC)*
- *1-ethylpyrrolidin-2-one (NEP)*

DMAC and NEP are currently used in various industrial and professional sectors, including synthetic fiber production, the pharmaceutical and agrochemical industries, coatings, and enamels. The use, production, and marketing of these two solvents are progressively restricted, starting December 23, 2026.

The EU update to the list of test methods that can be used to test the physicochemical, toxicological, and ecotoxicological properties of chemical substances comes into force on 8 January 2026.



Seven other methods already included in the discipline are modified in compliance with recent decisions agreed at international level within the OECD (Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development).

Finally, in alignment with the "CLP" Regulation 1272/2008/EC on Classification, Labelling and Packaging of substances and mixtures, the tools available for assessing exposure to chemical substances in the workplace are integrated.

As the REACH Regulation is updated every six months, for subsequent major changes, such as the inclusion of SVHC substances in **Annex XIV**, ALMECO S.p.A. will evaluate six-monthly reviews and update the declaration to reflect these changes.

The regulatory information contained in this list is available in the chemicals database, ECHA CHEM. To guarantee a smooth transition, REACH will also maintain up to date this dataset until **July 2026**.
